### W.L.R. Silva J.

At this stage Mr. Shanaka Ranasinghe who appears for the Accused-Appellant states that the circumstances have now changed and the respondent only son who was taken away to France by the mother of the child that is the wife of the respondent is missing and therefore he has to go to France to locate the child risking his life and liberty. In this case the respondent is charged for contempt of court for not reading the notice sent by court to produce the child in court. But soon thereafter on the next occasion he had produced the child in court. At this stage the child was handed-over to the custody of the mother and he is not informed as to the whereabout of the child and he doesn't even know its very existence. We are mindful of the fact that a father might risk his own life to protect his children. Although the respondent has committed contempt in our opinion he should be pardoned.

Therefore, we severely warn the respondent and acquit and discharge him.
