This is an appeal to set aside the judgment of the learned High Court Judge dated 13.05.2011. The 1st accused-appellant in this case was convicted of the murder of a man named Velaudan Mailwaganam and was sentenced to death.

The facts of this case may be briefly summarized as follows: On the day of the incident around 7.30 p.m. the accused who was using bad language near a Kovil was advised by Marimuttu not to use bad language as the service of the Kovil was in progress. At this moment, the accused-appellant inflicted an injury on said Marimuttu. Thereafter, the deceased and his nephew, Maradakanapathi went to see Marimuttu at his house and on their return, the 2nd accused who was acquitted by the learned High Court Judge came and pushed the deceased, Mailwanagam. As a result of this incident, Mailwanagam (deceased) fell on the ground. At this stage, the accused-appellant came to the place and attacked According to eye witness, the deceased with an axe. Maradakanapathi, the accused-appellant dealt three blows on the deceased with the axe. Post Mortem Report and the Medical Evidence corroborate the eye witness's evidence. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that there are no grounds to urge in this case. When we consider the evidence of this case, we see no reason to interfere with the learned High Court Judge's Judgment. We therefore, affirm the learned High Court Judge's Judgment and dismiss the appeal.

Appeal dismissed.
