The learned counsel for the petitioner supports the application for transfer. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits to court that the petitioner was charged for attempted murder in M.C. Panadura case No. 00816 and this incident has arisen in relation to a dispute of possession of a land in relation to which an application under section 66 of Primary Court Act had been filed. The learned Magistrate of Panadura made orders in that application under section 66 of the

Primary Court Act. Thereafter there were complaints in relation to the violation of the said order made by the learned Magistrate and proceedings had commenced against those who have violated.

The petitioner contended that an observation was made by the learned Magistrate in the course of the proceedings that he had made complaints to the J.S.C. against him for the transfer of earlier cases in relation to the same transaction and therefore the petitioner fear that he will not be given a fair trial before the same Magistrate.

The learned Senior State Counsel who is appearing for the respondents informs court that the respondents have no objection in transferring this case from the said Magistrate's Court.



Panadura case No. 00816 be transferred to the Magistrate's Court of Moratuwa and for the Magistrate Moratuwa to hear and conclude case No M.C. Panadura 00816.
