At this stage Mr. Guruge moves to withdraw the appeal provided the plaintiff-respondent waive the damages awarded to the plaintiff-respondent by the learned District Judge in his judgment dated 30.10.1998. Having considered the circumstances, Counsel for the plaintiff-respondent agrees to waive the aforesaid damages awarded to the plaintiff by the impugned judgment.

In view of the above agreement and submissions made by both the counsel, the Court allows the application for withdrawal and accordingly the appeal is dismissed. However, having considered the submissions of the learned counsel for the plaintiff-respondent the order to pay damages to the plaintiff by the defendant is set aside.

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed but the plaintiff-respondent is not entitled for the damages awarded in the judgment dated 30.10.1998.
