This is an appeal against the order of the learned High Court Judge refusing to issue a Writ of Certiorari in respect of a notice sent by the Anuradhapura Municipal Council calling upon the Appellant to show cause as to why the building in question should not be demolished. The learned High Court Judge has refused the application on the basis that the Appellant had an alternative remedy namely to show cause before the learned Magistrate if proceedings are instituted under the Municipal Council Ordinance.
