This matter is coming up today to ascertain the position with regard to the appointment of Provisional Trustee in terms of Section 17 of the Buddhist Temporalities Ordinance.

Learned D.S.G. appearing for the respondents submits that the main event of Devalaya i.e. the Asala Festival is in progress at the moment and therefore all the rituals pertaining to the Asala Festival have been completed as scheduled. Thereafter he submits that other administrative matters to be sort out and therefore the respondents are agreeable to appoint Mr. Gunasekera former Basnayaka Nilame as the

Provisional Trustee with effect from 12th August until the conclusion of the election.

It is further submitted that with regard to the holding of elections the decision has already taken to have the meeting on 25th August. Therefore question of Writ of Mandamus want arise. With the present undertaking Writ of Certiorari will also not arise.

Learned President's Counsel for the petitioner submits that, since the relief prayed by the petitioner had been administratively granted, he does not wish to proceed with this application. Accordingly proceedings are terminated.
