Learned Senior State Counsel informs court that in view of the order delivered in case No. C.A. (PHC) APN 25/2016 (Revision) she is moving to withdraw the objections already filed in this matter. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing was recovered from the 4th suspect and he further informs that he was arrested on the information provided by the suspect who was arrested previous to this person. He further submits that the suspect is in remand for two years and nine months and he moves that the suspect be released on bail.

Considering the submissions made by both counsel we set aside the order of the learned High Court Judge dated 02.03.2015, and we release the suspect on bail on the following conditions:

1. We order a sum of Rs. 100,000/- cash bail.

2. Two surety bail each Rs.500,000/-. The sureties must be

acceptable to the Learned Magistrate. The sureties must produce

Gramasevaka certificates on their residence.

3. The 4th suspect is directed to report to the Narcotic Bureau on 1st

and 3rd Sunday of every month between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00

noon until the conclusion of this case.

4. The passport of the 4th suspect is impounded and the Registrar of

this court is directed to inform the Controller, Immigration &

Emigration Authority accordingly.

Registrar is directed to forward a copies of this order to the

Magistrate's Court of Negombo and to the Officer - in - Charge,

Narcotic Bureau Colombo 01.
