### Order

#### A.L. Shiran Gooneratne J.

In support of the Petition the Learned President's Counsel moved to issue notice on the Respondents.

The substantive relief prayed for in prayer (b) to the Petition is to issue a mandate in the nature of a writ of certiorari quashing the decision to appoint the 37<sup>th</sup> Respondent to the post of Senior Lecturer, Grade II by letter of appointment marked P7. Document marked P7, as stated in paragraph 18 of the Petition is a document which contains the qualification and work experience of four (4) Candidates who had applied for the said post. Paragraph 16 of the Petition refers to an unsigned copy of the letter of appointment of the 37<sup>th</sup> Respondent, marked P6.

The prayer to the Petition refers to the said letter of appointment of the 37<sup>th</sup> Respondent as P7. Therefore as it stands, relief prayed for in item (b) to the prayer cannot be granted.

Since the said inadvertence amounts to a technical error, the Petitioner is directed to amend the prayer accordingly, and support.
