Appellant brought to the notice of this Court certain factors in favour of

the Accused-Appellant and the learned Deputy Solicitor General

brought to the notice of this Court that the victim had been 07 years of

the age at the time of the offence and the Accused had been 17 years of

age.

We also observed that the learned Trial Judge had not considered the

mitigatory circumstances when sentencing the Accused.

Considering the above mentioned submissions, we vary the sentence of the imprisonment imposed on the Accused-Appellant as follows;

01. For the 01st count, the imprisonment ordered by the learned Trial Judge is varied from 02 years rigorous imprisonment to 01 year rigorous imprisonment.

02. For the 02ndcharge, the learned Trial Judge had ordered 09 years rigorous imprisonment, which is varied to 07 years rigorous imprisonment and both terms of imprisonments to run concurrently from the date of conviction which is the 28.07.2020. The rest of the sentence to remain the same.

Subject to the said variations, the appeal is dismissed.
