The respondent-appellant has preferred the present appeal against the judgment of the learned High Court Judge to the dated 14 September 2009 by which he refused to exercise his revisionary jurisdiction in respect of the order

delivered by the learned magistrate on 1 April 2009 directing the ejectment of the respondent-appellant from the premises in question under the government quarters (recovery of possession) act no 7 of 1969 as amended.

In the impugned judgment the learned High Court judge inter alia has rejected the revision application on the ground that the respondent-appellant has failed to satisfy court as to the existence of any exceptional circumstances that warrant the exercise of revisionary powers vested in the High Court.

Having carefully perused the judgment of the learned High Court Judge, I am of the opinion that the impugned judgment of the learned High Court judge warrants no intervention of this court by the exercise of appellate jurisdiction.

Hence this appeal stands dismissed.
