Learned counsel was heard in support of this application. The Petitioners have filed this application in respect of the same grievance that was the subject matter in the case bearing No. CA (Writ) 282/09. That case was filed by a group of persons. The said group includes the petitioners as well.

Perusal of the order made by this court in that case shows clearly that this court had decided (as far back as on 2009.10.14) that this is not a fit case in which this court should issue notices on the Respondents. This Court on that basis had refused to issue notices.

Learned counsel for the petitioners conceded in the course of his submissions that it is the same cause of action which the petitioners re-agitate in this application. There is no submission on behalf of the petitioners that the circumstances prevailed in the year 2009 has changed.
